ReCreate is a national social enterprise that takes end of line and surplus stock from businesses to reuse as arts materials. ReCreate's warehouse is full with all types of fantastic arts materials such as paper, wool,

plastics, fabric, tubing, foam and many other unusual surprises.

Distribution of the materials is on a membership basis which will be at a nominal cost as ReCreate is looking to drastically reduce the budgets on arts materials for schools, whilst introducing a new dimension of encouraging creativity in both children and teachers. Additionally, tonnes of materials will be diverted annually from landfill as well as saving businesses on their disposal costs, ensuring everybody benefits.

The warehouse also includes a workshop area where ReCreate's members can learn how to transform regular business materials into stunning art pieces, plus it will have an inhouse art shop. ReCreate looks forward to welcoming you in 2014.
